## SHL: a year in numbers – Part 1



In this year's program (since August 2023)

- We have run 46 Adobe Connect workshops (and 6 more to go before the end of July)
- We have had 12 live broadcasts (and 4 more to go before the end of July)
- We have run 7 Adobe Connect live workshops new for the 23J year ☺
- 12 brand new topics
- New Neurodiverse community suite of events

## SHL: a year in numbers – Part 2



- Our most popular live broadcast was Tuition making the most of your tutor and tutorials' (494 people streamed live, and 829 have watched on YouTube catch-up!)
- Our workshop with the highest attendance was 'Managing your time better' in September (335 people!)
- 17,585 watches on Adobe catch-up and YouTube for SHL events this academic year, as of June 16th 2024
- 12,522 live interactions with an SHL event
- 4066 individual students attended Adobe workshops this academic year so far
