

What's expected in a tutorial



- Usually no video of student if they do ask you can always say you don't have one if you're uncomfortable about it
- Take part in the polls (anonymous)
- Take part in text chat (names visible on day but recording anonymous)
- Sometimes come on microphone but usually by invitation
- If you're uncomfortable about any of the types of interaction let your tutor know.



Recording



- Most are recorded
- If large group and repeated only one will be recorded
- Drop in ones not usually recorded
- Names in chat are anonymous in the recording (user 1, user 2 etc)
